John is married to Casey who is a licensed clinical social worker, and together they are parenting their three sons Josiah, Elliot, and Asa.

Mark your calendar and plan to participate in this upcoming church conference. An agenda with attachments will be shared by email prior to the meeting. There are a couple of items being finalized from our May 18 church conference.

(1) The Operations Team is

(1) The Operations Team is recommending that PHBC move forward with establishing an agreement with Christ the King Anglican Church to rent/lease PHBC facilities on Sundays from 4:00 pm – 8:00 pm and that the Operations Team be authorized to finalize as well as manage the lease/rental agreement on behalf of PHBC. This item was discussed in May, and the Operations Team has met with leaders from Christ the King to discuss details.

A Question/Response sheet is available for review before church conference. (2) The Support Team will recommend adoption of amended policies and procedures presented in the May church conference. (3) The Renovations/Construction Team will present updates on the proposed church sign. New estimates and options will be presented for review and discussion. A final vote will be scheduled at a future church conference. (4) There will be a financial update and reports from other church ministry teams. To assist the church family, the pastor will host ZOOM sessions on Monday, July 7 at 6:30 pm and Tuesday, July 15 at 6:30 pm. Zoom links will be shared by email. These sessions are opportunities to ask questions prior to the church conference. The business of the church is the church's business. Church members have direct input into the ministry direction

of the church by participating in ministry teams and voting at church conferences.

### Engagement Team Updates

On behalf of the Engagement Team, I thank you very much for the Lent Love Offering of over \$2900. We distributed \$781.46 to a 5-week summer reading program for some MSES students, \$939.42 to CBFNC for Wyatt's work with Welcome House Raleigh for refugee resettlement, and \$939.42 for the Salvation Army in Los Angeles for recovery from fires. We appreciate your support. The remainder of the offering will be used for disaster relief that may be needed this year.

During July we will emphasize Global Missions. We decided to collect an offering to assist the International Life Source church in Kenya at the Kakuma Refugee resettlement camp which houses over 300,000 individuals. Currently their needs are critical with much difficulty in the camp, based on a variety of services from humanitarian organizations such as USAID no longer provided. Food needs, healthcare and education are being negatively impacted. Currently a fully grown person is only receiving 6.6 lbs of food for an entire month. Please contribute as you are able. You can contribute cash or a check with the notation on the offering envelope designating it as the Global Offering for International Life Source Church. Soon there will be a link on the website for online contributions. Also be in prayer for their needs.

In August we will collect back to school supplies for needed materials for Mineral Springs Elem. School. Please bring donations to the church during the month of August. In lieu of shopping for needed items, you can contribute to the church with the designation of MSES school supplies. Please place your donations in the baskets beside the mission station in the hallway. Here are the requested items:
